*Dear Parishioners,*

*Saying hello is much easier than saying goodbye. I have enjoyed being part of the St Vincent's community these past 7 years. People always tell me how friendly we are, which is a great reputation for a parish to have. My priesthood, while not without suffering, has for the most part enabled me to have many joy-filled days. My favorite times were all people oriented whether it was preparing couples for marriage (while I do not have an accurate number of weddings I witnessed, I would say it was well over 4000 ceremonies with about 35 a year for my 6 years in Utica) or comforting families who suffered a death. I am sure I presided at well over 7000 funerals (in Utica I averaged 100 per year). I enjoyed teaching, youth ministry when I was a younger guy, and hospital chaplaincy. I have also trained spiritual directors for the past 36 years as well as serving as a spiritual director to many and offering pastoral counselling to those who had personal, marriage or family problems. Of course celebrating the Eucharist and offering homilies was a major part of my days and years; all in all a good run. I am looking forward to some "down time" over the summer and then finding out where the Lord wishes to lead me. Thanks for being a part of my life. I take with me many good memories of my time with you.*

*As part of our yearly tithe in gratitude for the many blessings we have received as a parish, with the consent of the Finance Committee, we offered gifts of \$500 each to the following ministries: Catholic Charities Men's Shelter, St. Vincent's Day Care, Bishop Grimes Scholarship Committee, our St Josephine Bakhita Clinic in South Sudan and Fr.
